### Let's learn

**Milligram:** A very small unit, often used for medications.

**Gram:** The base unit in the metric system, used for small items like spices or small amounts of food.

**Kilogram:** A larger unit, used for heavier items like groceries or body weight.

1000 milligrams = 1 gram

1000 grams = 1 kilogram
