

Dr Sharad Kumar Pandey is working as an Associate Professor of History in the Department of Curriculum Studies (DCS) at National Council of Education Research and Training (NCERT), New Delhi. He joined NCERT in March, 2006. Prior to that he was posted at North East Regional Institute of Education (NERIE), NCERT, Shillong, Meghalaya, for a decade. Hindi, English and Urdu. He has authored and reviewed several chapters written for NCERT and Indira Gandhi National Open University, (IGNOU) materials.
