

(i) Programme No.: 2.15 Programme Title : Orientation programme for master Trainers in Sanskrit from Upper Primary to Higher Secondary Stage (One programme for North East).

With the development of textbooks in Sanskrit as a follow up to NCF–2005 and the recent trends like CCE, it is felt necessary to orient the teachers teaching Sanskrit from upper primary to higher secondary stage about new approaches and trends in language teaching. This orientation will improve the quality of teaching and learning process.

(ii) Specific Objectives :

- i. To familiarize teachers of Sanskrit with the ideas and vision of NCF-2005.
- ii. To organize orientation programme with a view to orient master trainers in Sanskrit on new vision/approaches, methoDELologies, textbooks, CCE & RTE for effective teaching of Sanskrit from upper primary to higher secondary stage.

Methodology of the orientation will include lectures, discussions, group work, and presentations on different aspects of Sanskrit teaching.
