

Dr. Anjum Sibia is a Professor of Educational Psychology and In-charge of Manodarpan Cell, Department of Educational Psychology and Foundations of Education, NCERT. She has been working in the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) for the last 31 years. She has contributed to the development of National Curriculum Frameworks, Position Paper on Peace Education, Textbooks in psychology for Classes XI and XII, Learning outcomes at Secondary Stage, Working paper on Guidance and Counseling, and Integration of Affective Concerns in Teaching and Learning. As a member of various course committees, she also provided academic inputs for designing of psychology syllabi, B.Ed. courses, value/peace education, guidance and counselling programmes. Prof. Sibia has organized a number of training programs and has also provided consultancy to governmental/non-governmental agencies in the training of teachers, school counsellors, teacher educators and administrators in various programmes organised within and outside the NCERT.

She has contributed to the field by conducting research studies, preparing monographs and exemplar materials in the area of emotions and learning, innovative school practices, teacher questioning, emotional intelligence, qualitative techniques, caring in teaching and mental well-being.
