Dr. Sarita Chaudhary has been working as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Educational Psychology and Foundations of Education at NCERT, New Delhi since September 2023.

Dr. Sarita Chaudhary completed her M.Sc. in Chemistry from Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut, and her M.Ed. from Barkatullah University, Bhopal. She earned her Ph.D. in Education from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore. With eight years of experience in teaching at both schools and teacher education institutions, Dr. Chaudhary has made significant contributions to the field of education. She has published 15 research papers in various national and international journals, authored five books, and contributed five book chapters. Additionally, she has developed three units for the B.Ed. Open and Distance Learning course at Jammu University. Dr. Chaudhary also contributed a "Changing Perspectives on Curriculum Development" unit for the Knowledge and Curriculum module, developed by IUCTE, Department of Education, M.S. University of Baroda, Vadodara.
