Dear Shri Mohanty,

This is with reference to the discussions held on 6th September, 2014 under the Chairmanship of the Prime Minister with regard to the verification exercise undertaken by UIDAI and RGI.

2. You may be aware that it was decided in the aforesaid meeting that all databases will be digitized with Aadhaar number along with other data in Scholarship, LPG, PDS, Passports, Pensions, MNREGA and Persons imprisoned in jails/ on parole. The databases will be in standardized core formats developed by DeitY, leaving additional features for States/UTs to add, if required, with provision for Aadhaar numbers for each individual in the database.

3. DeitY is engaged in developing the eGovernance Standards that inter alia include the metadata and data standards (MDDS) and the technical standards including the biometric standards. MDDS - Demographic version 1.1 (Person Identification and Land Region Codification) has been notified by the DeitY in November, 2011, which can be leveraged to make the beneficiary details and related data elements of aforesaid databases in standard format. All the eGovernance standards including the aforementioned standards have been notified by the DeitY and are published at <https://egovstandards.gov.in>.

The data and metadata elements may be chosen by the respective department in accordance with its scheme requirements and the eGovernance standards notified by DeitY may be adopted for each data and metadata.
