	b) Desirable	1. Degree / Master's Degree in Education / Mass Communication 2. Experience in data collection and analysis, report / academic writing 3. Fluency in Hindi and English 4. NET qualified from UGC, however, non NET candidates may also apply.
2	Tenure	Upto 31 st March, 2023
3	Age	Below 40 Years as per UGC guidelines (5 years relaxation in the case of SC/ST and female candidates and 3 years in the case of OBC candidates)
4	Value of Fellowship	Rs. 25,000/- p.m. (Consolidated and fixed for NET qualified) Rs. 23,000/- p.m. (Consolidated and fixed for NON-NET)
